The ZBA cannot reply to statements made or answer questions raised during public comment but may add items presented to a future agenda.
5. Approval of Meeting Minutes: July 14, 2026
6. **Public Hearing: ZBA Case No. 26-05:** Owners John S. and Kathlene M. Berry have applied for a Special Permit pursuant to Section 179-25B of the Brewster Zoning Bylaw to alter, extend or change a preexisting, nonconforming single-family dwelling located fully within mapped conservancy soils at 97 Spring Lane, shown on Tax Map 48 Parcel 15, in the Residential Medium Density (RM) Zoning District. The Applicants seek to add a two-story addition to the rear of the property which will further intensify the property's existing Wetlands Conservancy District nonconformity. The Zoning Board of Appeals will consider and potentially vote whether to grant the special permit.
7. **Public Hearing: ZBA Case No. 26-06:** Owners Matthew J. and Michelle D. McDonough have applied for a Special Permit pursuant to Section 179-25B of the Brewster Zoning Bylaw to alter, extend or change a preexisting, nonconforming single-family dwelling located fully within mapped conservancy soils and within required yard setbacks at 23 Captain Dunbar Road, shown on Tax Map 91 Parcel 35, in the Residential Medium Density (RM) Zoning District. The Applicants seek to add and alter a front entry and rear deck which will further intensify the existing property's building coverage, Wetlands Conservancy District and yard setback nonconformities. The Zoning Board of Appeals will consider and potentially vote whether to grant the special permit.
